We Beseech you to hear our PEACEFUL petition, intervene on our behalf, and alleviate our suffering under the present non-government. We are fed up and cannot take it anymore!

We the people of St. Maarten withdraw our consent to be governed by the present government on the following grounds: It is evident to even the more biased observer that the present government is not capable of running the ship of state. There exists a vacuum of authority. No one represents the interest of the people. The air of impending doom hanging over the island can only be averted by releasing safely the pressure building up among the population, which we fear can lead to a social upheaval, the likes of which has never been seen on St. Maarten, or indeed the Netherlands Antilles. 2011 is the year of The People Revolution.
